

## **Dr. Joseph J. Marchetti**

### **Biography**

Dr. Marchetti assumed the role of Professor in the School of Education at Stockton University effective January 2010 after serving as a senior level administrator for twenty five years in the Division of Student Affairs, most recently as Vice President for Student Affairs. Between July 1, 2010 and April 2, 2012, Dr. Marchetti served as Interim Dean of the School of Education. He recently co-authored a new interdisciplinary doctoral program, Ed. D. in Organizational Leadership, which will be available in the coming months. Previously, he served as director of the Master of Arts in Educational Leadership (MAEL) Program at Stockton.

Dr. Marchetti's primary areas of interest include educational leadership, leadership development, organizational effectiveness and assessment, performance appraisal, organizational change, customer satisfaction, technology integration and workforce diversity. He has taught a number of courses related to these interests including "Educational Research" and "Program Assessment" for the Master of Arts in Education Program, "Research for Education Leaders" in the Master of Arts in Educational Leadership Program, "Emerging Paradigms of Leadership" for the Master of Business Studies Program, "Research in Instructional Technology", "Adult Learning", "Instructional Design and Development" and "Leadership in Instructional Technology" for the Master of Arts in Instructional Technology Program. He also has taught "Leadership Strategy and Change", "Schools of the Future" and "Intercultural Communication" as part of the General Studies program. Dr. Marchetti also co-designed a Freshman Seminar "Community Leadership" and currently teaches a Freshman Seminar, "Pathways to Learning".

Dr. Marchetti received a Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania in 1985 with academic emphasis in Organizational Leadership, Curriculum and Instruction. He holds a Master of Science in Educational Supervision and a Bachelor of Arts in Biology (PA Teaching Certificate Eligibility) and Psychology. His undergraduate and Master's work was done at Wilkes College, Wilkes-Barre, PA.

As Interim Dean, Dr. Marchetti was responsible for overseeing full-time graduate and undergraduate faculty, professional staff, clerical staff, adjunct faculty, supervisors of student teachers, cooperating teachers, and others working within the School of Education. In addition, all budget, reporting, national accreditation and assessment activities within the School were under his purview as well as the Southern Regional Institute and Educational Technology Training Center (SRI & ETTC), the Stockton Center for Community Schools (SCCS), the Stockton Center for Economic and Financial Literacy (SCEFL), and the alternate route certification programs. In addition to his teaching role, he served as a co-chair of the Middle States Commission of Higher Education Reaccreditation Process for Stockton (2012), as a Co-Chair of the Engagement Committee for Vision 2020, the College's Strategic Planning Process, and as Co-Chair of the Essential Learning Outcomes "Adapting to Change" work group. Dr. Marchetti also serves the Middle States Association as a review team member for other institutions participating in the accreditation process.

As a Student Affairs administrator, Dr. Marchetti was responsible for programs and services related to enrollment management, financial aid, student records and registration, student

services, campus and residential life, health and counseling services, and athletics and recreation. He also has extensive experience working with educational program assessment, professional development, budgeting and strategic planning. Dr. Marchetti served a three-year term on the James E. Scott National Academy for Leadership and Executive Effectiveness Board for the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators (NASPA). He served as the 2009 Director of the New Senior Student Affairs Officer Institute for NASPA and recently as an at-large member of the Region II Advisory Council for NASPA where he served as regional faculty liaison to the national organization.

Dr. Marchetti has worked throughout the years with the Southern Regional Institute and Educational Technology Training Center (SRI & ETTC) at Stockton which provides professional development and technology training for K-12 superintendents, principals and other administrators and community agencies. He also served as Co-Chair of the SRI & ETTC Leadership Forum.

Dr. Marchetti has nearly forty years of full-time professional experience in higher education. Prior to joining Stockton in 1985, Dr. Marchetti worked in professional roles at various institutions since 1976. His earlier professional experience included serving as an Assistant Dean of Student Affairs at Penn State University, Hazleton Campus; Assistant Dean of Students at College of the Holy Cross, Worcester, MA; and Director of Housing at Wilkes College.

Dr. Marchetti regularly conducts professional workshops and training programs and serves in various capacities on statewide and national organizations. He has also held volunteer leadership positions (including board appointments) in several community associations including Gilda's Club of South Jersey (Governance Committee Chair, and Strategic Planning Committee), the American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, the March of Dimes and Big Brothers/Big Sisters.
