Mr. Nicolas Michel is Professor of Public International Law at the Law Faculty of the University of Geneva, at the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies, and at the Academy of International Humanitarian Law and Human Rights in Geneva, since 1st September 2008. Before, and for four years, he served as Under-Secretary-General for Legal Affairs, The Legal Counsel of the United Nations.

From 1987 to 2004, he was a Professor of Public International Law and European Law at the Law Faculty of the University of Fribourg, Switzerland. Between 1998 and 2003 he joined the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs as the Director of the Public International Law Directorate. And from 2003 to 2004, he was the Jurisconsulte of the Ministry.

Mr. Nicolas Michel holds law degrees (licence, doctorate and *Privat Doцент*) from the University of Fribourg, an attorney's license, and a Master's degree in International Relations from the University of Georgetown, Washington, DC. He also holds a *honoris causa Doctorat* from the University Robert Schuman of Strasbourg. He is the author of several books and a number of articles on International and European law.
