The UNLV men's basketball team, winner of two straight games, will open play at the Sunshine Slam in Daytona Beach, Florida, against Florida State on Monday, Nov. 20. The 5:30 p.m. ET/2:30 p.m. PT game at the Ocean Center will be televised on CBS Sports Network.

ABOUT THE ROSTER: This season's UNLV squad features seven returners from last year's team along with seven newcomers. The newcomers are made up of three Division I transfers, a junior college transfer and three freshmen. UNLV has 10 upperclassmen, including five fifth-year seniors. A total of four players on the roster are playing in their hometown of Las Vegas. The Runnin' Rebels return two starters in Luis Rodriguez and Justin Webster, who averaged 10.7 and 8.2 points per game last season, respectively. Rodriguez led last season's team in rebounding (5.7 rpg).

EARLY SEASON RUNNIN' REBEL LEADERS: After three games, four UNLV players are averaging double figures in scoring in Kalib Boone (14.0 ppg), Luis Rodriguez (13.3 ppg), Jalen Hill (13.3 ppg) and Dedan Thomas Jr. (11.7 ppg). Hill leads the team in rebounds (8.7 rpg), while Dedan Thomas Jr. is the assists leader (6.3 apg). Over the last two games, Thomas Jr. has recorded 14 assists with zero turnovers.

LAST TIME OUT: UNLV won its second straight game in its first on the road this season at Pepperdine (82-68) on Friday night. Five Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures, led by Kalib Boone's 19 points on 9 of 10 shooting. Dedan Thomas Jr. added 17 points with five assists, Jalen Hill added 15, Jackie Johnson III had 13 and Luis Rodriguez scored 10. UNLV's bench outscored the Waves' 32-2 for the game.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT: Florida State has started the 2023-24 season with a 2-1 record, with home wins over Kennesaw State and Central Michigan (both with identical scores of 94-67). The Seminoles are coming off an 89-68 road loss at Florida on Friday. Four FSU players are averaging double figures in scoring: Cameron Corhen (12.7 ppg), Darin Green Jr. (12.7 ppg), Jamir Watkins (11.3 ppg) and Cam'Ron Fletcher (10.7 ppg). Corhen and Watkins are both at 5.0 rebounds per contest, while Jalen Warley leads in assists with 3.7 per game. Florida State finished last season with an overall record of 9-23, placing 12th in the Atlantic Coast Conference with a 7-13 league mark. The Seminoles were picked to finish 11th in their conference in this year's preseason poll. Led by head coach Leonard Harmilton, Florida State has 12 upperclassmen on its 20-member roster.

BROADCAST INFO: Monday's game will be televised on CBS Sports Network with Tom James and Mike O'Donnell calling the action. Jon Sandler, former Runnin' Rebel Curtis Terry and Steve Cofield will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 in Las Vegas. All streaming links and live stats are available at UNLVRebels.com and through the UNLV Rebels App.

LAST SEASON: The Runnin' Rebels finished the 2022-23 season with 19 wins. UNLV won two games over ranked teams, which marked the first time the program had won multiple games against top 25 teams in the same season since 2015-16. UNLV raced out to a hot start, going 11-1 in non-conference play after winning its first 10 games. The non-conference record was its best in 32 years and the 10-0 start was its best in 34 seasons. When the team was 10-0 it was receiving votes in both top 25 polls. EJ Harkless was named Second Team All-Mountain West when conference play concluded.

- The 2023-24 season marks the third as head coach for Kevin Kruger. Following his first season in 2021-22, Kruger was named one of 15 finalists for the Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I men's college basketball by collegeinsider.com. In his second season, UNLV won 19 games, defeated two ranked teams (the most for the program in a season since 2015-16), and recorded its best non-conference record (11-1) in 32 years after its best start to a season (10-0) in 34 years. After the 10-0 start the team received votes in both top 25 polls and Kruger was named ESPN's National Coach of the Week. Prior to being named head coach, Kruger was an assistant for the Runnin' Rebels for the previous two seasons (2019-21). The point guard on UNLV's 2007 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 Team as a senior under his father, legendary coach Lon Kruger, Kevin returned to Las Vegas after spending three years as an assistant coach at Oklahoma (2016-19). During his first season at the helm of the program, Kruger led the Runnin' Rebels to 18 wins the most for UNLV in four years. The team went 10-8 in Mountain West play, exceeding preseason expectations with a fifth-place finish in the league standings.
- This season's UNLV squad features seven returners and seven newcomers. The newcomers are made up of three Division I transfers, a junior college transfer and three freshmen.
- The 14-man roster includes 10 upperclassmen, including five fifth-year seniors.
- UNLV returns two starters in Luis Rodriguez and Justin Webster, who averaged 10.7 and 8.2 points per game last season, respectively. Rodriguez led last season's team in rebounding (5.7 rpg).
- Also back for the 2023-24 season are Jackie Johnson III, Isaiah Cottrell, Shane Nowell, Karl Jones and Nick Walters. Cottrell only played in one game last season because of injury.
 - The newcomers include Jalen Hill (fifth-year transfer from Oklahoma), Kalib Boone (fifth-year transfer from Oklahoma State), Keylan Boone (fifth-year transfer from Pacific), Rob Whaley Jr. (junior-college transfer from College of Southern Idaho), Dedan Thomas Jr. (freshman), Brooklyn Hicks (freshman) and Jacob Bannarbie (freshman).
- A total of four players on the roster are hometown guys from Las Vegas: Cottrell, Hill, Thomas Jr. and Walters.
- This marks the second straight year that the entire coaching staff returns: Barret Peery, John Cooper and Jamaal Williams. Peery came to UNLV from Texas Tech, Cooper from SMU and Williams from Portland State.
- UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West race by a vote from select media.
- Dedan Thomas Jr. was named the league's Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- The Runnin' Rebels went 19-13 overall last season, finishing seventh in the MW standings with a 7-11 league mark.

THE FLORIDA STATE SEMINOLES (2-1, 0-0 ATLANTIC COAST)

- Florida State has started the 2023-24 season with a 2-1 record, with home wins over Kennesaw State and Central Michigan (both with identical scores of 94-67).
- The Seminoles are coming off an 89-68 road loss at Florida on Friday.
- Four FSU players are averaging double figures in scoring: Cameron Corhen (12.7 ppg), Darin Green Jr. (12.7 ppg), Jamir Watkins (11.3 ppg) and Cam'Ron Fletcher (10.7 ppg).

- Head coach Leonard Hamilton is 22nd season at Florida State with a record of 428-267 (.616) and in his 36th season overall as a head coach with a career mark of 628-477 (.568). He was also the head coach at Oklahoma State (1986-90) and Miami (1990-00).

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark just the second all-time meeting between UNLV and Florida State in men's basketball.
- The only previous meeting occurred in Las Vegas on Dec. 22, 1990 when the Runnin' Rebels were ranked No. 1 in the country. UNLV won that contest 101-69.
- UNLV is 19-20 all-time against teams that currently make up the ACC.

UP NEXT

After playing Florida State on Monday, the Runnin' Rebels will then face either No. 25 Colorado or Richmond on Tuesday. Depending on Monday's outcomes, Tuesday's game will either be played at 1 p.m. ET/10 a.m. PT or 3:30 p.m. ET/12:30 p.m. PT. The earlier game will be televised by CBS Sports Network, while the later contest will be broadcast by FloHoops.

DEDAN THOMAS JR. NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PRESEASON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

UNLV men's basketball's Dedan Thomas Jr. was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year for the 2023-24 season as the league announced its preseason awards prior to the start of Men's Basketball Media Day at Resorts World in October. Thomas Jr. was a five-star recruit and ranked as the 22nd-best prospect in the class of 2024 by 247 Sports. He is the son of former Runnin' Rebel Dedan Thomas Sr. who played for UNLV from 1991-94 and earned honorable mention All-America honors. Thomas Jr., a Las Vegas native and a 6-foot-1-inch point guard, averaged 22.8 points and 5.1 assists per game as a junior last season at Liberty High School, leading the Patriots to the state championship final for a second straight year. He was named the Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of Nevada, before reclassifying and joining the Runnin' Rebels this summer. As a sophomore in 2021-22, Thomas Jr. led his school to the 5A

state championship, averaging 13.3 points per game that season. Thomas Jr. is UNLV's first MW Preseason Freshman of the Year honoree since Keshon Gilbert earned the same accolade prior to the start of the 2021-22 campaign.

HEAD COACH KEVIN KRUGER

Former Runnin' Rebel student-athlete and assistant coach Kevin Kruger was appointed the head coach of the UNLV's men's basketball program in March 2021. Following the 2021-22 season, Kruger was named one of 15 finalists for the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I men's college basketball by collegeinsider.com. During his first season at the helm of the program, Kruger led the Runnin' Rebels to 18 wins - the most for UNLV in four years. The team went 10-8 in Mountain West play, exceeding preseason expectations with a fifth-place finish in the league standings. He and his staff revamped the roster with nine transfers and the team continually improved as the season progressed, advancing 43 spots in the KenPom ratings along the way. Under Kruger's leadership, three UNLV individuals earned 2021-22 All-Mountain West accolades: Bryce Hamilton (First Team), Donovan Williams (Sixth Man of the Year) and Royce Hamm Jr. (Honorable Mention).

In Kruger's second season as head coach, the team won 19 games, including two over ranked teams. The two victories over top 25 squads are the most in a season for UNLV since 2015-16. The Runnin' Rebels raced out to a 10-0 start in 2022-23, marking the program's best in 34 years, while their non-conference record of 11-1 was their best in 32 years. After the 10-0 start, UNLV was receiving votes in both polls and Kruger was named the ESPN National Coach of the Week. EJ Harkless, a fifth-year transfer from Oklahoma State earned Second Team All-MW honors.

Prior to being named head coach, Kruger completed his second year as an assistant for the UNLV program in 2020-21 after he returned to his alma mater in April 2019. The point guard on UNLV's 2007 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 team as a senior under his father, legendary coach Lon Kruger, Kevin returned to Las Vegas after spending three years as an assistant coach at Oklahoma (2016-19). With Kevin on the coaching staff, Oklahoma made multiple NCAA Tournament appearances. He was also an assistant coach at Northern Arizona for two seasons (2014-16) following a year as a graduate assistant at Oklahoma. Prior to making the move into coaching, Kevin played professionally from 2007-13.

During his first season on the coaching staff at UNLV in 2019-20, the Runnin' Rebels tied for second place in the Mountain West, marking the program's best league finish in 12 years. The team also sent shockwaves through the college basketball world with its victory at fourth-ranked and previously undefeated San Diego State, posting the program's best true road win since 1991 (a span of 29 seasons). Achievement in the classroom has been just as important with Kruger on staff. The team turned in a semester grade point average of 3.57 for fall 2020, the program's highest ever. It also achieved a record-cumulative GPA of 3.32 with an all-time program-high nine student-athletes on the Dean's Honor List.

Kruger began his collegiate playing career at Arizona State, where he earned his criminal justice degree in 2006, before transferring to UNLV. In his lone season as a Runnin' Rebel student-athlete, UNLV won 30 games. He earned All-Mountain West Third Team honors and was named to the conference's all-tournament team. At ASU, Kruger was named an honorable mention All-Pac-10 and second-team NABC District 15 selection in his third and final season in Tempe. Also a Pac-10 All-Freshman honorable mention pick, Kruger left the Sun Devils ranked fourth in career free throw percentage at ASU, fifth all-time in 3-pointers made and attempted and seventh in 3-point percentage. Kruger had professional basketball stints in Bulgaria, Italy, China, Mexico, Belgium and Germany in addition to NBA training camp invitations from the Orlando Magic and Milwaukee Bucks. He also played with the Utah Flash and Los Angeles D-Fenders of the NBA D-League before launching his coaching career. His father, Lon, coached the Runnin' Rebels from 2004-2011 and made four NCAA Tournament appearances (2007, 2008, 2010 and 2011) and an NIT (2009). Kevin earned a master's degree from Oklahoma in human relations in 2017 and is married to the former Allison Gerding. The couple has two daughters, Cameron, who celebrated her fourth birthday in October and Vivienne, who was born in November 2021

PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST POLL

UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West standings as voted on by select media and announced during the conference's media days in October. San Diego State was predicted to win the conference title this season, while Boise State was second, New Mexico third, UNR fourth and Colorado State fifth.

"3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for most consecutive games scoring at least one 3-pointer. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 1,196 games played. With Vanderbilt failing to make one in a game during the 2019-20 season, UNLV and Princeton are the only schools left that have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the shot was introduced.

UNLV SIGNS THREE FOR 2024 - CLASS RANKED NO. 1 IN MOUNTAIN WEST, 37TH IN NATION

The Runnin' Rebel program has received signed commitments from Jeremiah "Bear" Cherry, James Evans and Pape N'Diaye (Pronounced: POP EN-jie) to join the UNLV men's basketball team for the 2024-25 season. The 2024 recruiting class for the Runnin' Rebels is currently ranked No. 1 in the Mountain West and 37th nationally in the 2024 Team Rankings on Rivals.com.

Cherry is a 6-foot-11-inch center from San Diego, who attends New Mexico Junior College. He averaged 11 points and seven rebounds last season as a freshman at the school. Regarded as one of the best junior college big men in the country, he attended St. Mary's Catholic High School. "Bear is a big physical post player that will fit in with how we want to play on both ends of the court," UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger said. "He has the ability to score around the rim and continues to improve. He comes from a well-respected national junior college program and we are excited that has chosen to join the Runnin' Rebel Family." Cherry, who will be a junior at UNLV when he arrives, comes from a basketball family as both of his parents played in college and his older brother, Taeshon, also played in college (Arizona State and Grand Canyon) and currently plays professionally overseas. Cherry chose UNLV over Florida State, Mississippi State, Boise State and Utah State.

Evans is a 6-foot-6-inch wing from Wichita, Kansas, and attends West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, California. He is ranked as one of the top 150 players in the class of 2024 by 247 Sports. "James is a good, young high school basketball player that has continued to get better every time we see him," Kruger said. "He has tremendous size and athleticism that will provide elite versatility at the wing position for us. We are excited to have him as a part of the Runnin' Rebel program." Evans, who will be a freshman at UNLV in 2024-25, plays for Paul George Elite on the Nike EYBL Circuit as well. He chose the Runnin' Rebel program over Washington and Utah State.

N'Diaye is a 7-foot forward from the Ivory Coast, who attends Trinity International in Las Vegas. He is ranked as the 97th best player in the class of 2024 by 247 Sports and is considered one of the best shot blockers in the country. "Pape has extraordinary length and skill," Kruger said. "He has a very high ceiling and is just scratching the surface on what he can become. We are excited to be able to add another local Las Vegas prospect to the Runnin' Rebels." N'Diaye will be a freshman at UNLV in the fall of 2024. He chose the Runnin' Rebels over Kansas, Miami, New Mexico and Colorado State.

ANDERSON HUNT'S JERSEY RETIRED AT THOMAS & MACK CENTER

Anderson Hunt, who is one of the most recognizable names in college basketball history, was honored with a jersey retirement at halftime of UNLV's game at the Thomas & Mack Center on Nov. 11. He played at UNLV under Hall of Fame Coach Jerry Tarkanian from 1988-91 and is probably most well known for earning Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors in 1990 after helping lead the Runnin' Rebels to the national championship. He is the UNLV career leader in 3-pointers made with 283 as a Runnin' Rebel and is the 13th-leading scorer in program history with 1,632 career points. He was inducted into the UNLV Athletics Hall of Fame as part of the class of 2022. His number 12 is the 12th player jersey to be raised to the rafters at the TMC.

LAST SEASON'S WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

- UNLV's win over then-No. 21 Dayton on Nov. 15, 2022 marked its first win over a ranked non-conference opponent
 at the Thomas & Mack Center since defeating then-No. 3 Arizona (71-67) on Dec. 23, 2014.
- Prior to the win over Dayton, UNLV's last win over any ranked team was during the 2021-22 season when it defeated then-No. 22 Colorado State in Fort Collins on Jan. 28, 2022. That win was its first win over a ranked team since Feb. 22, 2020 when it spoiled then-No. 4 San Diego State's bid at a perfect season.
- UNLV's win over then-No. 21 New Mexico on Jan. 7, 2023, gave the Runnin' Rebels two wins over ranked teams in the same season (2022-23) for the first time since the 2015-16 campaign when they beat No. 13 Indiana and No.
 15 Oregon.

NON-CONFERENCE RECORD IN KEVIN KRUGER'S FIRST TWO SEASONS

With an 8-5 non-conference record in Kevin Kruger's first season as head coach (2021-22), it marked the best non-conference mark for the Runnin' Rebels since they went 11-2 in 2017-18. With an 11-1 non-conference mark last season, it is the program's best in non-conference play by percentage since the 1990-91 team was 9-0 in non-conference action. Under Kruger, UNLV is 21-7 in non-conference play.

HOME MARK

The Runnin' Rebels went 12-4 at home during the regular season in 2021-22, with their only losses at the Thomas & Mack Center coming to then-No. 2 UCLA, San Diego State, Fresno State and Boise State (all ranked in the top 73 by KenPom). Last season, UNLV went 9-7 at home during the regular season. The Runnin' Rebels have won 22 of their last 34 regular-season games at the Thomas & Mack Center.

AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2023-24 season marks the 41st year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 532-151 (.779) in the arena since it opened in 1983. In 2021-22, UNLV recorded a regular-season home record of 12-4, which marked its best since the 2015-16 season (14-3).

66TH YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL

The 2023-24 season marks the 66th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,356-625 (.685).

SIXTH-WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

With an all-time record of 1,310-602 (.685) against four-year American institutions (entering the 2023-24 season), UNLV ranks as the sixth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I). The only schools ahead of UNLV are Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas, Duke and UCLA. UNLV has finished the season with a winning percentage above .500, 59 times in its 65-year history.

NBA DRAFT PICKS

UNLV had a total of four NBA Draft picks over a four-year span from 2013-16: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall in 2013 by the Cleveland Cavaliers), Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall in 2015 by the Milwaukee Bucks), Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall in 2016 by the Golden State Warriors) and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall in 2016 by the Orlando Magic).

RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA

There were two former Runnin' Rebels on NBA rosters when this season began: Derrick Jones Jr. (Dallas Mavericks), and Christian Wood (Los Angeles Lakers). Jones Jr., and Wood both went undrafted. Jones Jr. won the Slam Dunk Contest over Aaron Gordon during the 2020 NBA All-Star Weekend in Chicago on Feb. 15, 2020.

TURNING POINT: Southern used a 16-0 run over a five-minute stretch in the first half to take a 25-11 lead with 7:56 to go. The Jaguars increased their advantage to 19 points at the half, 40-21.

SECOND HALF: After shooting just 3 of 16 on 3-pointers in the first half (18.8%) and 7 of 26 overall (26.9%) over the first 20 minutes, UNLV performed better in the second half by making 6 of 13 3-pointers (46.2%) and 16 of 28 from the field (57.1%). However, Southern led by as many as 26 early in the second half, which proved too much to overcome. UNLV cut it to 13 with just under two minutes to play.

RUNNIN' REBELS WIN AT PEPPERDINE IN SEASON'S FIRST ROAD GAME, 82-68

Five UNLV players score in double figures as Runnin' Rebels win second straight

MALIBU, Calif. (UNLVRebels.com) - Five Runnin' Rebel players scored in double figures as the UNLV men's basketball team (2-1) won its second straight game and first road contest of the season Nov. 17 against Pepperdine, 82-68, at Firestone Fieldhouse.

Kalib Boone came off the bench to lead UNLV in scoring with 19 points on 9 of 10 shooting, Dedan Thomas Jr. scored 17 points with five assists and no turnovers, Jalen Hill scored all 15 of his points in the second half, Jackie Johnson III added 13 points on 5 of 7 shooting, including 3 of 5 on 3-pointers, and Luis Rodriguez had 10 points.

Pepperdine (3-2) was led by Michael Ajayi's double-double of 31 points and 12 rebounds, and Houston Mallette's 26 points with five made 3-pointers.

STATS OF THE GAME: UNLV's bench outscored Pepperdine's 32-2, the Runnin' Rebels made 58.2% of their shots and outscored the Waves 50-34 in points in the paint.

CONTROLLED FROM THE START: UNLV jumped out to a 10-3 lead to start the game, increased its advantage to 17-6 and led at halftime 40-30. The Runnin' Rebels were in control the rest of the way, leading by as many as 16 early in the second half. The closest Pepperdine came was six points at 59-53 with 9:51 to play but UNLV created additional separation, leading by 14 with just under five minutes to go.

QUOTABLE: "Because of how hard the guys worked in the first half, I thought we did a good job of wearing them down. Our trap in the backcourt was elite. We did a great job of mixing up the tempo and disrupting their transition. Holding a team like Pepperdine to 32% shooting on 3s on their home floor is going to win a lot of games." - UNLV head coach Kevin Kruger.

OTHER NOTES

- UNLV improved to 17-6 all-time against Pepperdine, snapped a two-game losing streak in the series and is now 6-5 in games played in Malibu.
- UNLV held Pepperdine to just 14.3% on 3-pointers in the first half (1 of 7) and 39.4% from the field in the second half (13 of 33).
