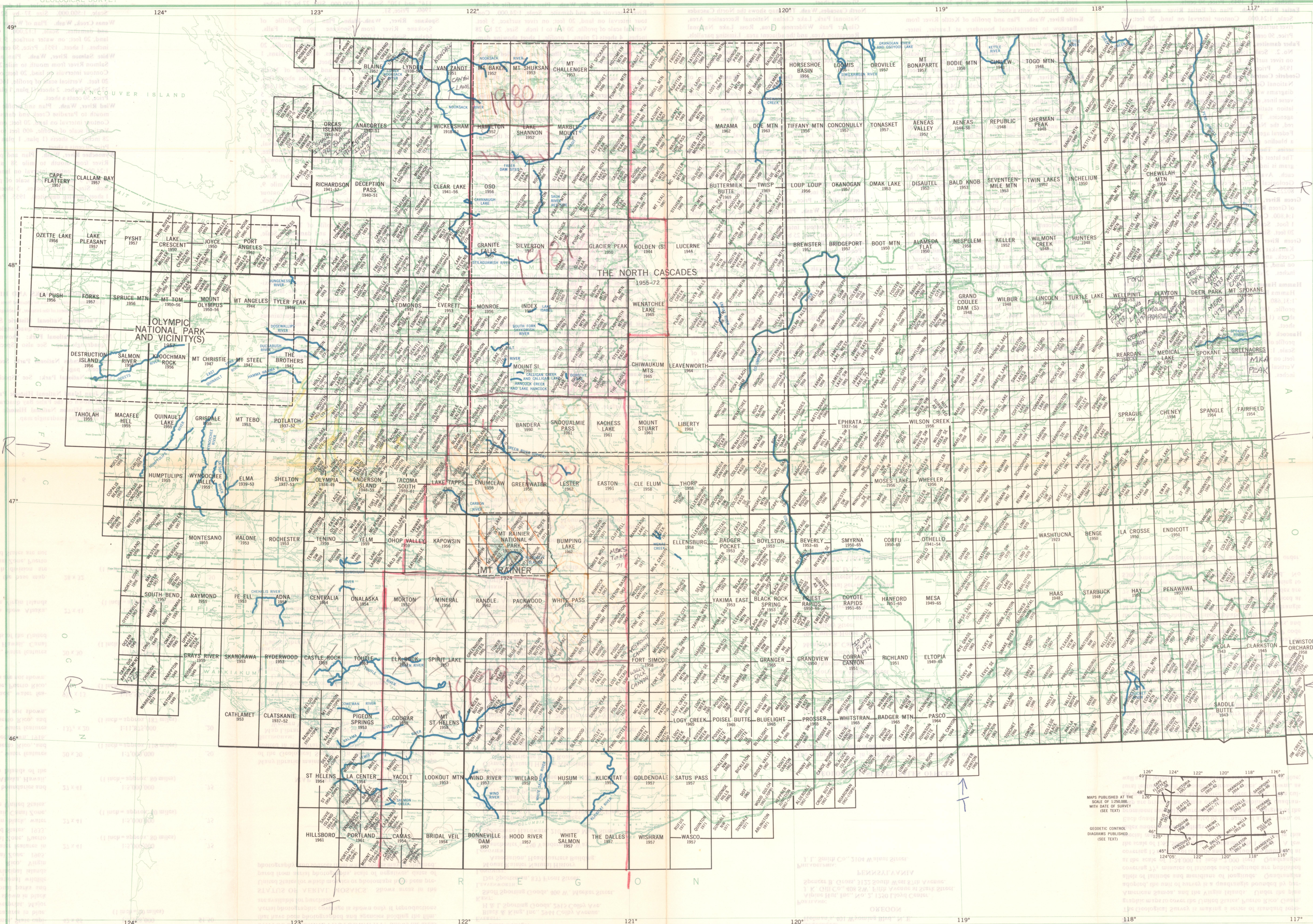

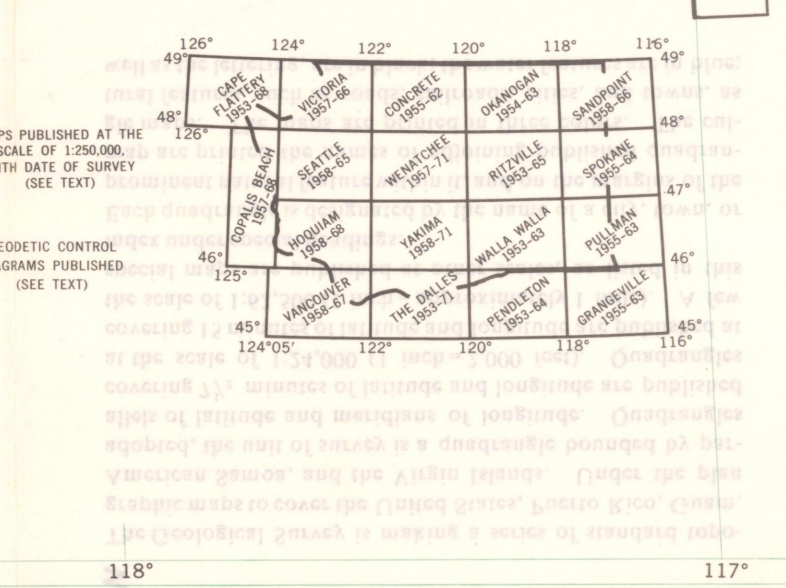

TOPOGRAPHIC MAPPING—STATUS AND PROGRESS OF OPERATIONS (7 1/2- and 15-minute series). Shows the status of topographic mapping and progress of operations in the United States by the Geological Survey and other Federal agencies. General appraisal of the adequacy of these maps is indicated by color patterns. Published annually.

STATUS OF AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY. Shows the areas that have been photographed and agencies holding the film. Aerial photographic coverage is shown only if reproductions are available for purchase.

STATUS OF AERIAL MOSAICS. Shows areas in the United States for which mosaics of photomaps have been prepared from aerial photographs, scale of negatives, dates of photography, and sources from which copies may be obtained.

WASHINGTON

The Geological Survey is making a series of standard topographic maps to cover the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, and the Virgin Islands. Under the plan adopted, the unit of survey is a quadrangle bounded by parallels of latitude and meridians of longitude. Quadrangles covering 7 1/2 minutes of latitude and longitude are published at the scale of 1:24,000 (1 inch = 2,000 feet). Quadrangles covering 15 minutes of latitude and longitude are published at the scale of 1:62,500 (1 inch = approximately 1 mile). A few special maps are published at other scales, as listed in this index under special headings.

Each quadrangle is designated by the name of a city, town, or prominent natural feature within it, and on the margins of the map are printed the names of adjoining published quadrangle maps. The maps are printed in three colors. The cultural features, such as roads, railroads, cities, and towns, as well as the lettering, are in black; the water features are in blue;

and the features of relief, such as hills, mountains, and valleys, are shown by brown contour lines.

The contour interval differs according to the scale of the map and the relief of the country. On maps that contain supplemental information additional colors are used, such as green for woodland areas and red for highway classification, urban areas, and United States land lines. A booklet describing topographic maps and symbols is available free upon request. The extent of map coverage is shown on the index map, on which the mapped areas are outlined in black. Quadrangles for which published maps are available have the quadrangle name, publishing agency (if other than the Geological Survey), and the date or dates of survey also printed in black. A list of special maps and sheets is given on the following pages. Further information concerning maps may be obtained from the National Cartographic Information Center, Geological Survey, Reston, Virginia 22092.

MAP SELECTION. A map should be ordered by name, series, and State in which it is located. In many instances, an area is covered by two maps which carry the same name, but are published at different scales. Where this occurs, it is especially important that the map order include the series designation, such as 7 1/2-minute, 15-minute, or 1:250,000. Most topographic maps and sheets are available with or without green woodland overprint. Maps showing woodland overprint will be supplied unless maps without the overprint are specified. The Geological Survey does not supply mounted maps.

An order form is included with each index, but maps may be ordered without a form. The name, address, and ZIP code of the purchaser should be typed or printed on all orders, and the maps desired should be listed alphabetically.

MAP PRICES AND SHIPMENT. Standard quadrangle maps published in the 7 1/2- or 15-minute series are priced at 75 cents a copy. Prices of other maps listed in this index are indicated in the descriptive text. On an order amounting to \$300 or more at the list price, 30% discount is allowed. No other discount is applicable.

Prepayment is required and must accompany each order.

Payment may be made by money order or check payable to the Geological Survey. Prices include surface transportation for shipments within the 50 States, to United States possessions, and to Canada and Mexico. If special transportation is requested, the entire cost must be paid by the purchaser. For shipments to Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico, a surcharge of 25% of the net amount of the order must be included in the payment. At the purchaser's request, maps will be shipped by air. The entire cost of such transportation must be included in the payment, but the 25% surcharge is waived.

WHERE TO ORDER MAPS. Maps of areas east of the Mississippi River, including Minnesota, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands of the United States should be ordered from the Branch of Distribution, U. S. Geological Survey, 1200 South East Street, Arlington, Virginia 22202. Maps of areas west of the Mississippi River, including Alaska, Hawaii, Louisiana, American Samoa, and Guam should be ordered from the Branch of Distribution, U. S. Geological Survey, Federal Center, Denver, Colorado 80225.
